

EXTRA PRECAUTIONS IMPLEMENTED AT KINDERPLATZ IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19

Following the ever-evolving guidance from our health consultants, DHS licensing, and the MN Department of Health, Kinderplatz is currently implementing the following extra precautions in response to COVID-19:

1. **Extra sanitizing** of frequently touched surfaces, multiple times per day (*toys, furniture, light switches, iPads and other electronic devices, and door, fridge, and faucet handles, etc.*).
2. **Social distancing** between adults (*staff-staff, staff-parent, parent-parent*)
3. **Reduced group sizes** per state guidelines
4. **Hand sanitizer for adults** to use at both hallway entrances
5. **One-way hallways** to support adult-adult social distancing
6. **Classroom drop-off/pick-up at the door** (*reducing the number of adults who enter the classrooms*)
7. **Cloth face coverings for staff** to use (*along with strict usage and handling guidelines*), especially at drop-off/pick-up and when serving food
8. **Stricter exclusion guidelines** for symptomatic children and adults per the MN Department of Health
9. **Visitor protocol established** and shared with any visitors who come into the facility
10. **New venue for summer field trips** and in-house events, with smaller groups
11. **Adjustments to summer soccer program practices** (*small group sizes, extra sanitizing, modified teaching practices to minimize proximity and contact with each other, etc.*)

We will continue to adjust our practices as needed to meet the most recent health and safety recommendations.
